- 5. licensing information [not pictured]





Using Pressbooks

TOP RIGHT: Uses a standard WordPress-based WYSIWYG editor. Editing texts and inserting media is as easy as writing in a word-processor. Many collaborators can work together on the same text with different roles & permissions.

BOTTOM RIGHT: Also has a drag-and-drop chapter organizer interface. Lets you create front & back matter, as well as two-level 'parts' & 'chapters' organization for main content.
